Elections in Italy – The election of Giorgia Meloni (leader of the far – right Brothers of Italy party and Italy's first female prime minister.

The new prime minister of England Liz Truss who replaced Boris hasn't got off to a good start being forced to do a U Turn on tax cuts.

The aggressive tightening of monetary policy by the US Federal Reserve which has impacted currencies worldwide. The NZ \$ is currently at the lowest it has been since the first nationwide lockdown in March 2020 sitting at \$.57 to the UDS.

All this has a flow on effect to our economy—From predicted shortages in eggs, toilet paper, glasses & food shortages and increases in our cost of imports and inflation. The low dollar is favourable for exporters, but it puts pressure on imports which fuels price increases and inputs for businesses.

The outlook is that forecasters are confident that the dollar will rebound to back over \$0.60 to the USD within the next six months.
